OFFICIAL PARADE RULES & REGULATIONS

Date: Saturday, November 25, 2022

All Trinidad and surrounding area businesses, groups, and citizens are invited to participate.

- 1. Entries will be judged on use of **lights**, color and music. Creativity and use of **lights** will weigh heavily in the judging. (music and animation encouraged)
- 2. Award Categories are: Prize Categories are: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place only for the entire parade
- 3. There is an **entry fee of \$35.00 per float or per vehicle** to accompany the Registration form.
 - Please make checks payable to Hometown Holidays.
 - Registration form and payment may be mailed to 608 E. 2nd Street, Trinidad, CO 81082, **or** delivered to that address.
 - Or registration can be emailed to HometownHolidaysTrinidad@gmail.com and bring payment to the parade
- 4. **Please** submit entries by **Saturday**, **November 18**, **2023**. **Please try your best to meet this date** (gives **time to organize the parade**). Cancellations should be reported immediately. <u>No refunds will be given</u> after deadline date of November 18 th.

5. LINE UP

- All entries should report to line up **no later than 5 p.m.**
- Committee members will be present to assist with line-up and assign a entry number
- Please enter-the-line-up from the intersection of CCOMMERICAL AND CEDAR and proceed toward the intersection of Chesnut and Elm.
- All entries will be expected to maintain their assigned positions throughout the parade
- 6. The parade will start at **6 p.m**. Parade route is as follows:
 - Proceed east on Elm to Oak Street, Turn right onto Oak Street
 - Proceed south to East Main Street, Turn right onto East Main Street
 - Proceed to west to Animas Street, Turn right onto Animas Street
 - <u>Disburse AFTER clearing the intersection of Animas & Modica NOT BEFORE.</u> You can turn right, left, or go straight and then disburse leaving space after intersection for the other exiting floats.

- 7. **FOR SAFETY REASONS, THROWING CANDY IS PROHIBITED.** Passing out candy on foot is allowed.
- 8. Santa Claus has already accepted our invitation to appear in the parade. No other Santa will be allowed to participate in the parade. ANY ENTRY WITH A SANTA IMPERSONATER WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THE AWARD COMPETITION.
- 9. **Judging** (by independent citizens) will be at **Chappell House** (Mullare-Murphy Funeral Home) on the corner of Main and Walnut.

Give your float the best chance to win a prize!! For the best presentation of your float and to give our independent judges a reasonable opportunity to review your float, please do not rush past the judging stand at the Chapell House-----Slow and steady does it!!
